** INSURANCE PLANS **

Elwood offers full-time employees a wide range of generous insurance plans to help offset the increased costs associated with illness, accidents, and disability. Elwood provides these plans either free or at a substantial savings to the employee. Any premiums paid for by the employee are deducted before your wages are taxed (referred to as "pretax"), providing the employee even further savings by reducing your taxable wages.



*MEDICAL INSURANCE:

Our medical insurance plan gives you the freedom to see any physician or other health care professional from their network, including specialists without referral.

*HEALTH SAVINGS ACCOUNT (HSA):

Allows for payment of non-covered expenses with pre-tax dollars.



*DENTAL INSURANCE

(INCLUDES VISION CARE DISCOUNT

PROGRAM):

Our dental plan provides a comprehensive program to ensure your dental health. Coverage is included for important preventative care, and also for treatment needed as a result of dental disease or accidental injury. Vision Insurance is available at a reduced group rate. Policy provides materials-only coverage.



*SHORT TERM DISABILITY INSURANCE:

Available at reduced group rates.

Policy pays 66 2/3% of pre-disability earnings after one week.

*LIFE AND ACCIDENTAL DEATH & DISMEMBERMENT INSURANCE:

No cost to employee. Policy pays \$50,000 Death Benefit.

*LON9_TERM DISABILITY INSURANCE:

No cost to employee. Policy pays 60% of predisability earnings after 180 days.

*WORKERS COMPENSATION INSURANCE:

Company provided for occupational illness and injury.



Holidays

At Elwood we believe that having time to enjoy the company of family and friends during the holidays is important. As an Elwood employee, you will enjoy 8 paid holidays off per year to kick back and relax.



PAID VACATION

Planning a vacation? We know you work hard, so Elwood provides you with a vacation plan that gives you plenty of time off to play. As an Elwood employee, you will be awarded 10 full days per year of vacation starting after your first year of employment. When you reach 5 years of employment with Elwood, your paid vacation time increases to 15 days. Long term employees with 15 years of loyal service are rewarded with 20 days of vacation.



SICK/EMERSENCY LEAVE DAYS

In addition to the generous paid vacation time allotted, Elwood employees receive 5 "Sick/Emergency Leave" days per year. Employees are encouraged to "bank" any unused Sick/Emergency Leave days as protection from absences due to long-term illnesses or injuries.
